Product Overview

Description	Monkey ald-keto reductase family 1 member C3 (AKR1C3) ELISA kit is an ELISA-based <i>in vitro</i> research tool designed specifically for the quantitative detection of AKR1C3 in monkey with a range of 250-5000 pg/mL and a specificity of 1.0 pg/mL.
Assay Principle	The kit is based on AKR1C3 antibody-AKR1C3 antigen interactions (immunosorbency) and an HRP colorimetric detection system to detect AKR1C3 antigen targets in samples.
Background	AKR1C3 is a steroidogenic enzyme that catalyzes the conversion of aldehydes and ketones into alcohols and belongs to the ald-keto reductase family. Studies have found that it may be associated with certain pathological processes.
