Product Overview

Description	Canine 6-phosphofructo-2-kinase/fructose-2,6-biphosphatase 3 (PFKFB3) ELISA kit is an ELISA-based <i>in vitro</i> research tool designed specifically for the quantitative detection of PFKFB3 in canine samples. The kit is highly sensitive and easy to use.
Assay Principle	The ELISA analytical biochemical technique is based on PFKFB3 antibody-PFKFB3 antigen interactions (immunosorbency) and an HRP colorimetric detection system to detect PFKFB3 antigen targets in samples.
Background	PFKFB3 is a key bifunctional enzyme responsible for both the synthesis and degradation of fructose-2,6-bisphosphate (the most potent allosteric activator of the glycolytic rate-limiting enzyme PFK-1). Consequently, its activity is one of the primary determinants of cellular glycolytic flux. Given its pivotal role in glycolysis, PFKFB3 plays a significant role in diseases such as obesity.
